### **What are the Economic Costs of implementing SWPBIS in Comparison to the Benefits of Reducing Suspensions ([click here for the article](#))**

Great information to share with school boards and staff. Initial evidence that SWPBIS is less expensive to implement than the longer-term costs related to suspensions and dropout. This finding is important as the benefits of reducing suspensions and dropout go far beyond simple fiscal savings. An analysis of the available data suggests that SWPBIS may be an economical alternative to not only ineffective approaches, like suspension, but also traditional dropout prevention programs.
