Implementing PBIS in High School with Fidelity

<u>This</u> brief shows research behind what it takes to implement successfully in a high school setting. High schools in the High Fidelity group in this research, demonstrated that (a) defining and teaching school-wide practices are critical for reaching high fidelity, (b) high schools struggle to implement Rewards Systems, and (c) high schools have fairly robust Violations Systems.

Often when we talk about positive behavioral interventions and supports (PBIS), we focus on student behavior — what it looks like, how we can improve it, reward it, discipline it, and report it. What about the role of the adults? This is the third in a series taking a closer look at the roles adults play in implementation.

NCII builds the capacity of state and local education agencies, universities, practitioners, and other stakeholders to support implementation of intensive intervention in literacy, mathematics, and behavior for students with severe and persistent learning and/or behavioral needs, often in the context of their multi-tiered system of support (MTSS) or special education services. NCII's approach to intensive

intervention is **data-based individualization (DBI)**, a research-based process that integrates the systematic use of assessment data, validated interventions, and intensification strategies.

The October Catch: Research's crystal ball.

Office Discipline Referral (ODR) data is one piece in a school's decision-making puzzle. Not only does reviewing referral patterns give you and your school team a picture of what's happening school-wide, it also gives you another way to identify students in your building who could benefit from targeted supports.1,2 Using ODR data this way in October – as a screening tool – is something called The October Catch.
