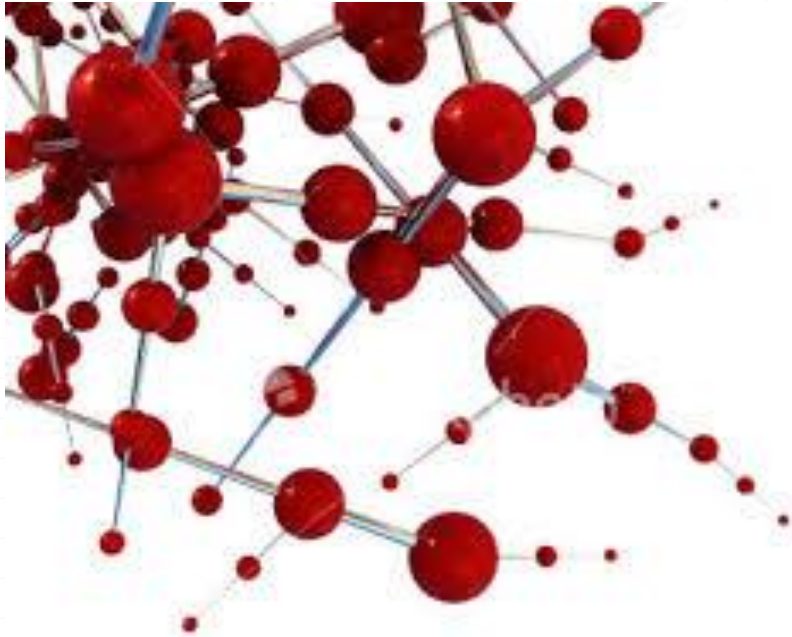

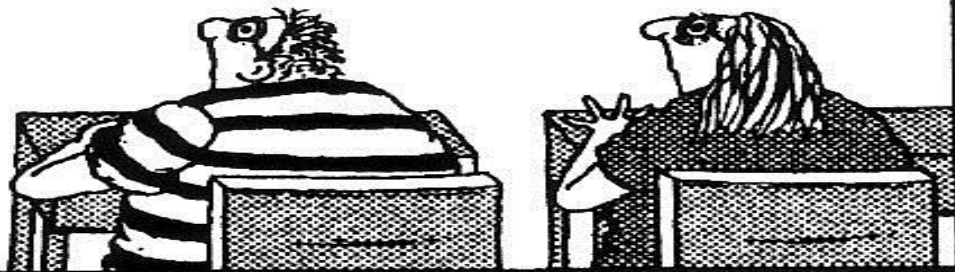

 - Passports

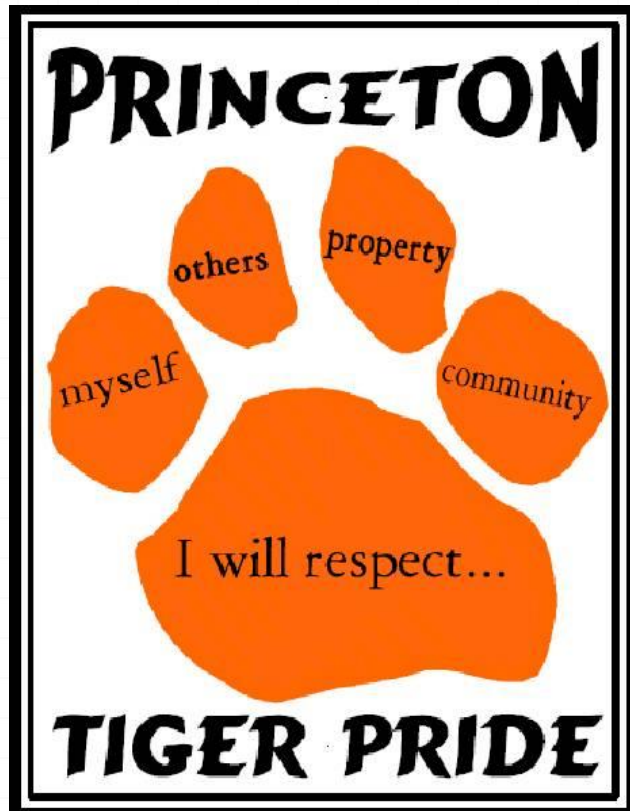
- 2) Positive Relationships

Data: How we're using it

- o Monthly data meetings
 - o School wide (trends, comparison, Top 5)
 - o Team wide
 - o Identifying students who need Tier 2/Tier 3 support
 - o BOY = Specific behavior plans
 - o Replacement behaviors  Academic goals
- o Next steps with data:
 - o Progress monitoring
 - o Tier 2 interventions/Fluid grouping
